

VOTE IN THE DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY 2024



THREE METHODS TO VOTE BEFORE THE POLLS OPEN ON APRIL 28, 2024

1) Absentee Ballot

- Any voter can obtain an Absentee Ballot application at the Puerto Rico State Election Commission's ("CEE" by its Spanish acronym) website www.ceepur.org or at any of the CEE eleven (11) regional offices or six (6) open JIPs.
- The application period begins on January 24, 2024, and ends on March 14, 2024.
- Any voter can apply for an absentee ballot without an excuse. No reason is required.
- The voter will receive the ballot by mail, proceed to cast their vote, and return the ballot by mail in the pre-addressed envelope provided by the CEE.

2) Advance Vote (Traditional)

- Advance voting is available for CEE officials, voters at work, long-term hospitalized voters, voters with physical disabilities, and others.
- You can obtain an application at the CEE website www.ceepur.org or at any of the CEE eleven (11) regional offices or six (6) open JIPs.
- The application period begins on January 24, 2024, and ends on March 9, 2024.
- The voter will receive the ballot by mail, proceed to cast their vote, and return the ballot by mail in the pre-addressed envelope provided by the CEE, or at CEE offices on a determined date.

3) Early Vote

• Early voting will be held eight **(8) days before the Democratic Presidential Primary**, from Saturday, April 20 through Saturday, April 27.

- Voting hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- To vote early, voters must attend **in person** to one of the polling places in their senatorial district.
- The polling stations for early voting are the eleven (11) CEE regional offices, six (6) JIP offices and thirteen (13) additional special polling stations in different towns to be announced.
- It is important to note that voters may only vote in the senatorial district where they are registered and must be active in the Puerto Rico Registrar of Voters.
- In addition, voters must present a valid ID as required by the Election Code, such as a driver's license, U.S. passport or the voter identification card issued by the CEE.
- The voting process will be carried out by the Added by Hand ("Añadido a Mano") method.
